## Letter of intention

*For the promotion of International cooperation between  
The Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Computer Sciences  
of the Marie Curie-Skłodowska University (Lublin, Poland)*

&

*The Faculty of Physics & Engineering of the University of Strasbourg (France)*

We confirm hereby the interest of the Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Computer Science as in signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between our faculties, or even more broadly universities, about the exchange of students at the graduate (Master) as well as postgraduate (Doctoral) levels using various already existing programs as for instance Erasmus or others Polish or French forms of cooperation.

Another possibility of the cooperation would be to provide the opportunities to our best students and facilitate obtaining the diplomas of both universities in a similar way as it has already been practised in a few cases employing the agreement FR-PL on 'theses-en-cotutelle'. This purpose needs for sure a special organisation of our studies and it could be achieved for instance in a form

of patronage of your Faculty (or the whole UdS) on certain fields of studies, e.g. the Science and Technology studies held (in English) at the Marie Curie Skłodowska University.

We would also like prepare an agreement which would enable our good, English-speaking graduates, to continue their studies at the UdS within simplified formalities. Of course such agreement should work also in the opposite direction if such interest will be on the side of the UdS students. It is expected that the MoU would define the framework encouraging the exchange of lecturers and researches in framework of the Erasmus and bilateral FR-PL programs.
